AN ACT REINSTATING THE SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR HIGH MILEAGE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (110) of section 12-412 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to reinstate the sales tax exemption on electric passenger
- 3 motor vehicles and other passenger motor vehicles that have a United
- 4 States Environmental Protection Agency estimated city or highway
- 5 gasoline mileage rating of at least forty miles per gallon.
