AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF ALARM AND SECURITY SYSTEM INSTALLERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require all alarm and
- 2 security system installers be licensed by the Department of Consumer
- 3 Protection, by submitting evidence of passage of an educational
- 4 curriculum or test recognized by the Commissioner of Consumer
- 5 Protection and by submitting to a background check, to be conducted
- 6 or approved by said department. The Commissioner of Consumer
- 7 Protection shall specify training and technical requirements required
- 8 for such licensure.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers by requiring the licensure of all alarm and security system installers.
