**AN ACT DESIGNATING MAY AS LYME DISEASE AWARENESS  
MONTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is  
2 amended by adding subdivision (69) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (69) Lyme Disease Awareness Month. The Governor shall  
4 proclaim the month of May of each year to be Lyme Disease  
5 Awareness Month to heighten public awareness of the associated  
6 presentation and available treatments for Lyme disease. Suitable  
7 exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the  
8 Governor designates for the observance of the month.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
