**AN ACT WAIVING FIREARM TRAINING COURSE REQUIREMENTS
FOR CERTAIN VETERANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 529 of the general statutes be amended to provide for
- 2 waiver of the firearms training course requirement for issuance of a
- 3 gun permit for veterans who (1) have been honorably discharged from
- 4 the armed forces, (2) have applied for such permit not later than two
- 5 years after the date of discharge, and (3) provide evidence of
- 6 satisfactory completion of a firearm training course taken during
- 7 service in the armed forces that is equivalent in content and quality to
- 8 that required in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for waiver of certain gun safety courses for veterans.
