**AN ACT MAKING STUDENTS WITHOUT LEGAL IMMIGRATION
STATUS ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS AND LOANS FOR
HIGHER EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to make students
- 2 without legal immigration status who have been admitted to a public
- 3 institution of higher education in this state eligible for scholarships,
- 4 grants and loans.

Statement of Purpose:

To make students without legal immigration status eligible for
scholarships, grants and loans for higher education.
