**AN ACT CONCERNING EQUAL ACCESS TO FINANCIAL AID
REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Office of Higher Education to establish procedures and forms that
- 3 enable a person classified as an in-state student for tuition purposes
- 4 pursuant to subdivision (9) of section 10a-29, or who meets equivalent
- 5 requirements adopted by said office, to apply for and participate in all
- 6 student aid programs administered by this state.
