***AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEDICAID FRAUD INVESTIGATORS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 51 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Medicaid Fraud Control Unit of the Office of the Chief State's Attorney
- 3 to hire the maximum number of investigators permitted by the federal
- 4 government under the federal program that provides reimbursements
- 5 to states for seventy-five per cent of the costs associated with hiring
- 6 such investigators.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase the number of investigators in the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit.
