**AN ACT REQUIRING FUNDS FROM THE BUDGET RESERVE FUND
AND ANY EXCESS REVENUE TO BE USED TO PAY INTEREST
RELATED TO STATE BORROWING FOR UNEMPLOYMENT
COMPENSATION BENEFITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that funds from the
- 2 Budget Reserve Fund and any excess revenue be used to pay any
- 3 interest due on amounts the state borrows from the federal
- 4 government for unemployment compensation benefits.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate future imposition of special assessments on businesses to pay interest on amounts borrowed from the federal government for unemployment compensation benefits.
