**AN ACT CONCERNING REDUCTIONS TO THE MINIMUM BUDGET  
REQUIREMENT FOR TOWNS THAT ACHIEVE EFFICIENCIES AND  
LOWER COSTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 10-262i of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to allow any district that realizes new and documentable
- 3 savings through increased intradistrict efficiencies approved by the
- 4 Commissioner of Education to reduce such district's budgeted
- 5 appropriation for education in an amount equal to the savings
- 6 experienced as a result of such intradistrict efficiencies.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To authorize towns to reduce their minimum budget requirement to  
reflect cost efficiencies found in school district budgets.
