AN ACT CONCERNING A MORATORIUM ON NEW CHARTER SCHOOLS AND A REVIEW OF EXISTING CHARTER SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-66bb of the general statutes be amended to place a
- 2 moratorium on the approval of new charter schools by the
- 3 Commissioner of Education; and further that the Department of
- 4 Education conduct a review of existing charter schools for the purpose
- 5 of replicating and implementing successful programs and models in
- 6 the public schools in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To get charter schools and public schools to work together to benefit the greatest number of students.
