**AN ACT REPEALING ENROLLMENT RESTRICTIONS AT
AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION
CENTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part IV of chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 replace the provision requiring local and regional boards of education
- 3 to designate the agricultural science and technology education centers
- 4 that a student may attend with a provision allowing students to attend
- 5 any agricultural science and technology education center in the state
- 6 and to require the local or regional board of education otherwise
- 7 responsible for educating such students to pay the tuition for such
- 8 students.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the restrictions on enrollment at vocational-agricultural schools so as to allow students the same choice of an agricultural science and technology school as they have for a magnet school.
