***AN ACT REQUIRING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL FOR THE INCREASE
OF GRANTS UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 9-705 of the general statutes,
- 2 concerning the adjustment, in accordance with any change in the
- 3 consumer price index, of grants awarded under the Citizens' Election
- 4 Program, be amended to (1) require the approval of a majority of each
- 5 chamber of the General Assembly for any increase in the amount of
- 6 such grants, and (2) provide that any increase in the amount of such
- 7 grants shall not exceed the amount of any change in the consumer
- 8 price index for the time period since the amount of such grants was
- 9 last adjusted.

Statement of Purpose:

To require an affirmative vote of the General Assembly in order to
increase the amount of the grants provided under the Citizens'
Election Program.
