AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY POWER IN SENIOR HOUSING COMPLEXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 8 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Housing Commissioner to issue regulations requiring owners of
- 3 developments housing not less than one hundred senior citizens to
- 4 have emergency power generators capable of providing sufficient
- 5 power to ensure the health and well-being of elderly tenants.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide sufficient power to ensure the health and well-being of elderly tenants in housing developments of not less than one hundred units.
