**AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCEMENTS TO THE SEX OFFENDER
REGISTRY SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 969 of the general statutes be amended to restructure
- 2 the sex offender registry system into a three-tier offense-based system
- 3 and to increase registry terms, to require registrants to provide
- 4 additional information to the Department of Emergency Services and
- 5 Public Protection, including the name and address where the registrant
- 6 is employed, the license plate number and vehicle description of any
- 7 vehicle owned or operated by the registrant, and telephone and cell
- 8 phone numbers of the registrant and to require registrants to be subject
- 9 to in-person verifications to provide accurate accounting of a
- 10 registrant's physical location.

Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen Connecticut's sex offender registry laws and to ensure
Connecticut law is compliant with the Adam Walsh Child Protection
and Safety Act of 2006.
