**AN ACT STAYING A TERM OF INCARCERATION DURING THE
PENDENCY OF AN APPEAL OF A FAMILY COURT ORDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that, if in a family
- 2 court matter one of the parties is ordered to be incarcerated and such
- 3 party appeals the order of incarceration, such party shall not be
- 4 incarcerated during the pendency of the appeal.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide parties to a family court matter with certain clearly defined rights and protections against wrongful incarceration during the pendency of an appeal of an order entered in such family court matter.
