AN ACT CONCERNING COERCED ABORTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to create criminal penalties for
- 2 anyone who forces or coerces a woman to have an abortion, to require
- 3 mandatory reporting of suspected forced or coerced abortions and to
- 4 create civil penalties against employers, educational institutions, social
- 5 assistance agencies or medical personnel who threaten a woman with
- 6 the loss of employment or other opportunity for refusing to terminate
- 7 her pregnancy.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent the coercion of a woman to have an abortion.
