AN ACT CONCERNING EXPEDITIOUS RULINGS BY THE COURT IN CHILD CUSTODY CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-56 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that not later than fifteen days following the date of a hearing on a
- 3 child custody matter, the court shall enter custody and visitation
- 4 orders for such matter, and that in the absence of such an order by the
- 5 court with the fifteen-day period, the parties shall share equally in the
- 6 custody and parenting time of the child.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that child custody hearings are promptly decided by the court.
