**AN ACT CONCERNING PURSUIT OUTSIDE OF PRECINCTS BY
POLICE OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-1f of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 sworn members of any local police department, outside of their
- 3 respective precincts, may arrest, without previous complaint and
- 4 warrant, any person for any offense when the person is taken or
- 5 apprehended in the act or on the speedy information of others, and
- 6 that whenever such sworn member of a local police department makes
- 7 any such arrest, such sworn member shall immediately notify the local
- 8 police department or state police troop having jurisdiction over the
- 9 precinct in which the arrest was effected.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow police officers to make arrests anywhere within the state of Connecticut.
