**AN ACT CONCERNING ATTORNEY FEE AGREEMENTS IN
MUNICIPAL TAX APPEALS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 12-117a and 12-119 of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to provide that no person may be represented in a municipal tax
- 3 appeal by an attorney or combination of attorneys on a contingent fee
- 4 basis that includes an agreement calling for an aggregate fee of more
- 5 than twenty per cent of any court ordered or informal reduction in
- 6 taxes collected from the person as a result of such appeal.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure fairness in the tax appeal process.
