AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF VIDEO CAMERAS IN FAMILY COURT PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 815j of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Judicial Branch to videotape all family relations matters except those
- 3 proceedings that are closed to the public because of allegations of
- 4 sexual abuse of children.

Statement of Purpose:

To require videotaping of most family court proceedings.
