AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPHRINE ON SCHOOL BUSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 169 of the general statutes be amended to require each
- 2 local and regional board of education to provide training for school
- 3 bus drivers and monitors concerning the administration of
- 4 epinephrine in an emergency and to provide legal immunity for such
- 5 drivers and monitors who, in good faith, administer epinephrine.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that there is a trained adult on each school bus that is qualified to administer epinephrine in the case of an emergency, reduce response times in such circumstances and save lives.
