**AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR  
BARBERS AND HAIRDRESSERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to enable barbers
- 2 and hairstylists licensed in another state or country who seek a license
- 3 to work as a barber or hairdresser in Connecticut to receive some
- 4 benefit in the licensing process for having an out-of-state license.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To revise the licensing requirements for those seeking a license to work as a barber or hairdresser in Connecticut.
