**AN ACT CONCERNING A CAP ON DOCUMENTATION FEES
CHARGED BY AUTOMOBILE DEALERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to create a maximum cap of
- 2 one hundred dollars on the amount automobile dealers can charge for
- 3 documentation fees related to administrative costs of the title,
- 4 registration and other paperwork involved with the car purchase.

Statement of Purpose:

To create more consistency and fairness in the amount different automobile dealers charge for documentation fees and to alleviate excessive costs when purchasing a vehicle.
