**AN ACT CONCERNING A THOUSAND ACRES CAMPAIGN WITHIN  
THE OFFICE OF BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION AND DEVELOPMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 588g of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Office of Brownfield Remediation and Development to establish the
- 3 Thousand Acres Campaign, whose mission shall include consolidating
- 4 current brownfield remediation programs and setting a schedule for
- 5 achieving an initial goal of identifying, remediating and repurposing
- 6 one thousand acres of brownfields in the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a Thousand Acres Campaign to identify, remediate and repurpose brownfields in the state.
