**AN ACT EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHILDREN'S
ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT AND REQUIRING PARENTAL
NOTIFICATION OF THIRD-PARTY VENDOR DATA COLLECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to expand the provisions of
- 2 the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act to children ages thirteen
- 3 to eighteen, inclusive, and to require that any contract that a local or
- 4 regional board of education enters into with a third-party education
- 5 vendor shall include a requirement that the parents and guardians of
- 6 students be notified about what student data will be collected and for
- 7 what purpose.

Statement of Purpose:

To apply and expand the provisions of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act to Connecticut and to require all contracts with third-party education vendors to include a notification provision regarding the collection and use of student data.
