AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY LIFE-THREATENING FOOD ALLERGIES IN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study the implementation and
- 2 enforcement of the guidelines for the management of students with
- 3 life-threatening food allergies and glycogen storage disease, developed
- 4 by the Department of Education pursuant to section 10-212c of the
- 5 general statutes. The task force shall submit such study to the joint
- 6 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to education and public health, in accordance with the
- 8 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a task force to study life-threatening food allergies in schools.
