**AN ACT CONCERNING THE SAFE DISPOSAL OF UNWANTED
PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AT PHARMACIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 21a-12f of the general statutes be amended to require:
- 2 (1) A secure locked box that is accessible to the public on a twenty-
- 3 four-hour daily basis for the anonymous drop-off of unwanted
- 4 pharmaceuticals at pharmacies that operate ten or more retail locations
- 5 in this state, and (2) the transport of such pharmaceuticals to an
- 6 appropriate facility for witnessed incineration. The provisions of this
- 7 section shall not apply to schedule I controlled substances.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect public health by removing unwanted pharmaceuticals from the community.
