AN ACT CONCERNING STANDARDS FOR TELEMEDICINE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to develop
- 2 standards for telemedicine to include requirements for (1) two-way
- 3 electronic audio and visual communication, (2) secure video
- 4 conferencing, (3) secure technology for the transfer and storage of data,
- 5 and (4) the primary physician to have personally seen the patient and
- 6 to be licensed and practicing in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To remove barriers to health care through the appropriate use of technology by establishing standards for telemedicine.
