***AN ACT CONCERNING MAIN STREET COMMITTEES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish Main Street
- 2 committees dedicated to improving the physical appearance and
- 3 broaden the retail mix in urban street corridors. Said committees shall
- 4 be established in municipalities with populations of one hundred
- 5 thousand or greater and ten million dollars in bonds shall be
- 6 authorized for the purpose of carrying out the goals of said Main Street
- 7 committees.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To prevent urban main street corridors from losing more retail stores which can affect neighborhood quality of life and economic development.
