**AN ACT CONCERNING A WAIVER FROM THE FEDERAL
STANDARDIZED TESTING REQUIREMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Department of Education be required to seek a waiver from
- 2 requirements of the No Child Left Behind Act, P.L. 107-110, from the
- 3 United States Department of Education that permits the state to
- 4 require only those students enrolled in grades three, five, seven and
- 5 eleven to take the mastery examination.

Statement of Purpose:

To obtain a waiver from the United States Department of Education that limits the administration of the mastery examination to students in grades three, five, seven and eleven.
