AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM BUDGET REQUIREMENT FOR TOWNS WITH DECLINING STUDENT ENROLLMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 10-262i of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) repeal the limit that a school district may reduce its
- 3 budgeted appropriation for education in an amount not to exceed one-
- 4 half of one per cent of the district's budgeted appropriation for
- 5 education when a district experiences a decline in the number of
- 6 resident students, and (2) increase the multiplier from three thousand
- 7 to six thousand in the calculation allowing a town to reduce its
- 8 budgeted appropriation for education when the number of resident
- 9 students of such town decreases.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow school districts to reduce their budgets in an amount that reflects the degree of declining enrollment.
