AN ACT CONCERNING ALTERNATIVE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR EXPELLED STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 10-233d of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) ensure that all students under eighteen years of age,
- 3 who have been expelled, receive access to an alternative educational
- 4 opportunity during the period of expulsion; (2) require the local or
- 5 regional board of education for such expelled student to provide
- 6 information to the parents or guardians of such expelled student about
- 7 the alternative educational opportunities available to such expelled
- 8 student; and (3) require that such alternative educational opportunity
- 9 provide at least fifteen hours of actual school work per week.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide alternative educational opportunities to all expelled students under eighteen years of age.
