AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO CONSTRUCT A BLACK BOX THEATRE IN THE TOWN OF STRATFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 six million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Stratford for the
- 7 construction of a black box theatre.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize bonds of the state to construct a black box theatre in the town of Stratford.
