***AN ACT CONCERNING RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE JUVENILE JUSTICE POLICY AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 46b-121n of the general statutes be amended to provide  
2 that the Juvenile Justice Policy and Oversight Committee continue its  
3 assessment of existing state agencies and operational systems within  
4 the state which manage, oversee, collaborate and operate directly  
5 relating to the Connecticut juvenile justice system. The committee shall  
6 review, during the period from January 1, 2016, to December 31, 2018,  
7 inclusive, at a minimum, the Department of Education, the  
8 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, the Judicial  
9 Department, the Department of Children and Families, related statutes  
10 and regulations, diversion procedures, recidivism tracking and policy,  
11 and alternative education programs.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require the Juvenile Justice Policy and Oversight Committee to continue its review of the state's juvenile justice system.
