AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN'S SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2015*) The Department of Children and
2 Families shall initiate a study to determine whether policy and
3 procedural changes within the department may increase the safety of
4 children within the state. The department shall report, in accordance
5 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, the findings
6 of such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
7 having cognizance of matters relating to children on or before
8 February 1, 2016.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
