AN ACT REDUCING THE COST OF MAGNET SCHOOL TUITION FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-264l of the general statutes be amended to permit
2 any local or regional board of education located in the Sheff region, as
3 defined in subsection (k) of section 10-264l of the general statutes,
4 except for the Hartford school district, that has greater than five per
5 cent of its resident students, as defined in section 10-262f of the general
6 statutes, enrolled in an interdistrict magnet school program to not be
7 financially responsible for the portion of the per student tuition
8 charged in excess of such five per cent and that the Department of
9 Education shall be financially responsible for such excess per student
10 tuition.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide relief to certain school districts for the costs associated with magnet school tuition.
