**AN ACT CONCERNING THE SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECT AT THE
GAFFNEY SCHOOL IN NEW BRITAIN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That, notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (18) of section
- 2 10-282 of the general statutes, or any regulation adopted by the State
- 3 Board of Education or the Department of Administrative Services
- 4 pursuant to said section, requiring that not less than seventy-five per
- 5 cent of a building to be renovated is at least thirty years old, the
- 6 extension and alteration project at the Gaffney School in New Britain
- 7 (Project No. 089-0167 EA) shall be considered for renovation status.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the extension and alteration project at the Gaffney School in New Britain to be considered a renovation project for the purposes of a school construction grant.
