***AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO ANIMAL IMPORTER RECORDS REQUIREMENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 22-344f of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2015*):

4 (b) Each animal importer shall maintain a record of: [the] (1) The  
5 veterinary services rendered to each dog or cat imported into this state  
6 by such animal importer, and (2) adoption information, including, but  
7 not limited to, the date of adoption, the location of such adoption and  
8 the name and address of the person who adopts such animal. Such  
9 [record] records shall be maintained by such animal importer for a  
10 period of three years. Any animal importer who violates the provisions  
11 of this subsection shall be fined five hundred dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2015</i>	22-344f(b)
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**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the creation and retention of records concerning the adoption of animals from animal importers.
