AN ACT REQUIRING THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER TO ISSUE AN ANNUAL STATEMENT ON STATE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 5-141b of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 [The] Not later than January 1, 2016, and annually thereafter, the
4 Comptroller [may] shall issue a statement to all state employees which
5 shall include a summary of medical benefits, survivors' benefits and
6 normal retirement benefits for each employee and a summary of
7 general salary and other fringe benefit provisions.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the State Comptroller to issue an annual statement to state employees to notify such employees of their various benefits.
