AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FLOOR STOCK ALLOWANCES AND DEPLETION ALLOWANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Consumer
2 Protection shall study floor stock allowances and depletion allowances
3 and the effects of such allowances on alcoholic liquor permittees. Not
4 later than January 1, 2016, said commissioner shall report, in
5 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
6 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
7 cognizance of matters relating to alcoholic beverages concerning the
8 results of such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
