***AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S
RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL
DESIGN GUIDELINES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 19a-89b of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

3 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 4-166 and 4-168, the
4 Commissioner of Public Health may establish public swimming pool
5 design guidelines without adopting such guidelines as regulations for
6 purposes of establishing minimum standards for the proper
7 construction and maintenance of public swimming pools.

8 ~~[(a)]~~ (b) The Department of Public Health shall charge a fee of fifteen
9 dollars for a copy of its public swimming pool design guidelines.

10 ~~[(b)]~~ (c) The department shall charge a fee of fifteen dollars for a
11 copy of its food compliance guide.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
