AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF A GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 53a-181e of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

3 (a) A person is guilty of stalking in the third degree when [he] such
4 person recklessly causes another person to reasonably fear for his or
5 her physical safety by wilfully and repeatedly following, either in
6 person or by means of an electronic device, or lying in wait for such
7 other person.

8 (b) Stalking in the third degree is a class B misdemeanor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2015</i>	53a-181e

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that stalking in the third degree can include repeatedly following another person by means of an electronic device.
