AN ACT CONCERNING STANDARDS FOR THE USE AND SHARING OF DRIVER INFORMATION CAPTURED BY MONITORING DEVICES OFFERED BY INSURERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) The Insurance
2 Commissioner shall adopt regulations in accordance with the
3 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes to establish standards
4 for the use and sharing of driver information captured by monitoring
5 devices offered by insurers and ensure that such information, if used
6 as a factor in underwriting or rating private passenger nonfleet
7 automobile insurance policies, is used in a consistent manner. Such
8 regulations shall include, but not be limited to, the manner in which
9 such information may be used as an underwriting or rating factor, the
10 purposes for which an insurer may use such information, the entities
11 with which an insurer may share such information, the length of time
12 an insurer may retain such information and requirements for
13 notification to insureds about the use and sharing of such information.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
