**AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATORY REGISTRAR OF VOTER
SESSIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-17 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 the registrars of voters of each town shall hold only one mandatory
- 3 session to examine the qualifications of electors and admit those found
- 4 qualified prior to each regular election.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce costs for municipalities by only requiring one session for
registering voters prior to an election instead of three.
