AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS IN CERTAIN CONSUMER TRANSACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit retail businesses
- 2 from requiring persons to provide social security numbers in
- 3 consumer transactions in order to gain access to an Internet web site or
- 4 to enter into a retail business's computer system.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers against identity theft.
