**AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYER RETALIATION AGAINST
IMMIGRANT WORKERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any employer from
- 2 engaging in any unfair immigration-related practice against an
- 3 employee for the purpose of retaliating against such employee for
- 4 exercising any right afforded to him or her pursuant to the provisions
- 5 of chapters 557 to 559, inclusive, 561, 563a, 566a, 567, 568 or 571 of title
- 6 31 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent employers from engaging in unfair immigration-related practices as retribution for an individual exercising his or her rights.
