AN ACT CONCERNING AN EXPANSION OF THE CARE 4 KIDS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-749 of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 extend applicant eligibility in the child care subsidy program from
- 3 eight months to one year, (2) allow parents or caretakers who are
- 4 attending institutes of higher education to be eligible for child care
- 5 subsidies, and (3) allow information regarding participants in the child
- 6 care subsidy program to be shared with other government-sponsored
- 7 programs in which the participants may be enrolled.

Statement of Purpose:

To lessen the difficulties parents face when applying for the Care 4 Kids program.
