***AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF INDIVIDUALS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES' CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT REGISTRY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 319a of the general statutes be amended to provide  
2 that (1) no individual shall be removed from the child abuse and  
3 neglect registry until not less than seven years has passed since the  
4 individual was first included on said registry, (2) any application for  
5 removal from said registry be accompanied by notice to any victims,  
6 (3) no such removal shall occur until the Department of Children and  
7 Families has adopted regulations governing instances of removal, and  
8 (4) the department report annually to the General Assembly: (A) The  
9 number of requests for removal that were received, (B) the number of  
10 individuals removed from said registry in the previous year, and (C)  
11 for each individual so removed, the name of the person who requested  
12 such removal, the date and the nature of the abuse that caused the  
13 individual to be listed on said registry, and certain other information  
14 that the department deems necessary and proper to protect the  
15 children of the state.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To create standards for the Department and Children and Families to remove an individual from the abuse and neglect registry.
