AN ACT CONCERNING THE PHASE-IN OF THE INCREASED CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 (1) a minimum of twenty-three credits in order to graduate from high
- 3 school for classes graduating in 2020 and 2021, (2) a minimum of
- 4 twenty-four credits in order to graduate from high school for classes
- 5 graduating in 2022 and 2023, and (3) a minimum of twenty-five credits
- 6 in order to graduate from high school for classes graduating in 2024,
- 7 and each graduating class thereafter.

Statement of Purpose:

To phase in the new high school graduation credit requirements.
