AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish the Office of
- 2 Inspector General within the office of the Auditors of Public Accounts
- 3 that shall be responsible for the detection, prevention and investigation
- 4 of fraud, waste and abuse in the management of state government,
- 5 state employees and the use of state property in addition to the
- 6 investigation of whistleblower complaints and representation of
- 7 whistleblowers in any action against the state, and (2) transfer the staff
- 8 and resources of the Attorney General's Office that are currently used
- 9 to investigate whistleblower complaints and allegations of corruption,
- 10 mismanagement or the waste or abuse of state resources to such office.

Statement of Purpose:

To create the Office of Inspector General in order to reduce waste, fraud and abuse in state government and improve efficiency in the management of state resources.
